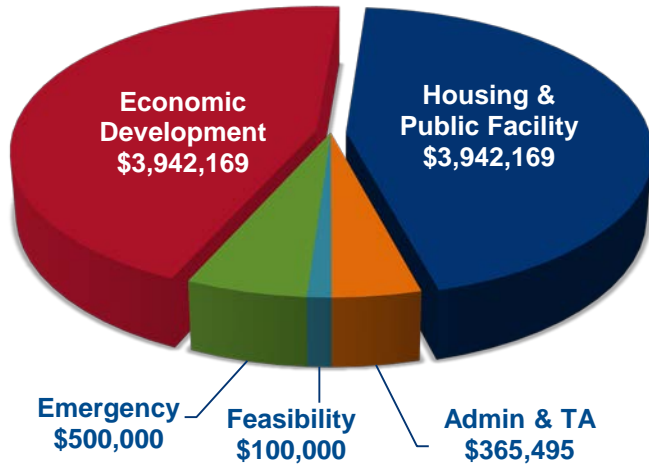

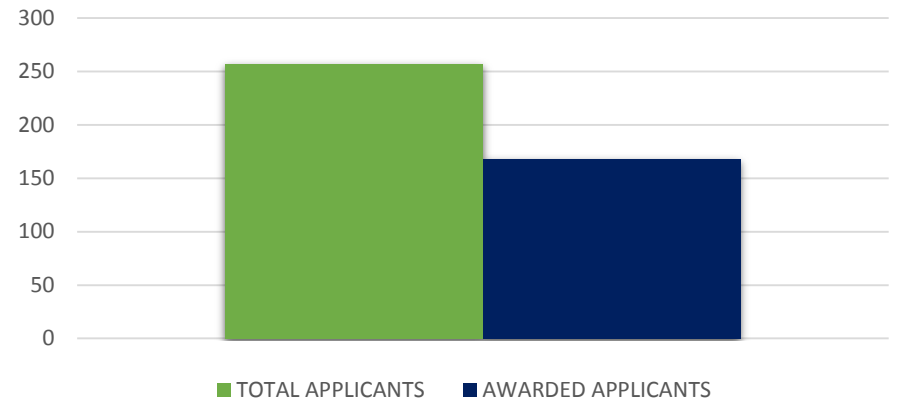
2018 CDBG Allocation

CDFA Applicant Trends



CDFA has invested more than \$37 million in community development, economic development and clean energy initiatives throughout New Hampshire since 2016. The demand for funding from applicants over this same period of time exceeds \$71 million.

CDBG Impact

January to December 2017 the CDBG program achieved the following impacts across the State:

- Assisted 1,947 people;
- Rehabbed or preserved 211 housing units;
- Created 108 jobs; and
- Supported 334 micro businesses.

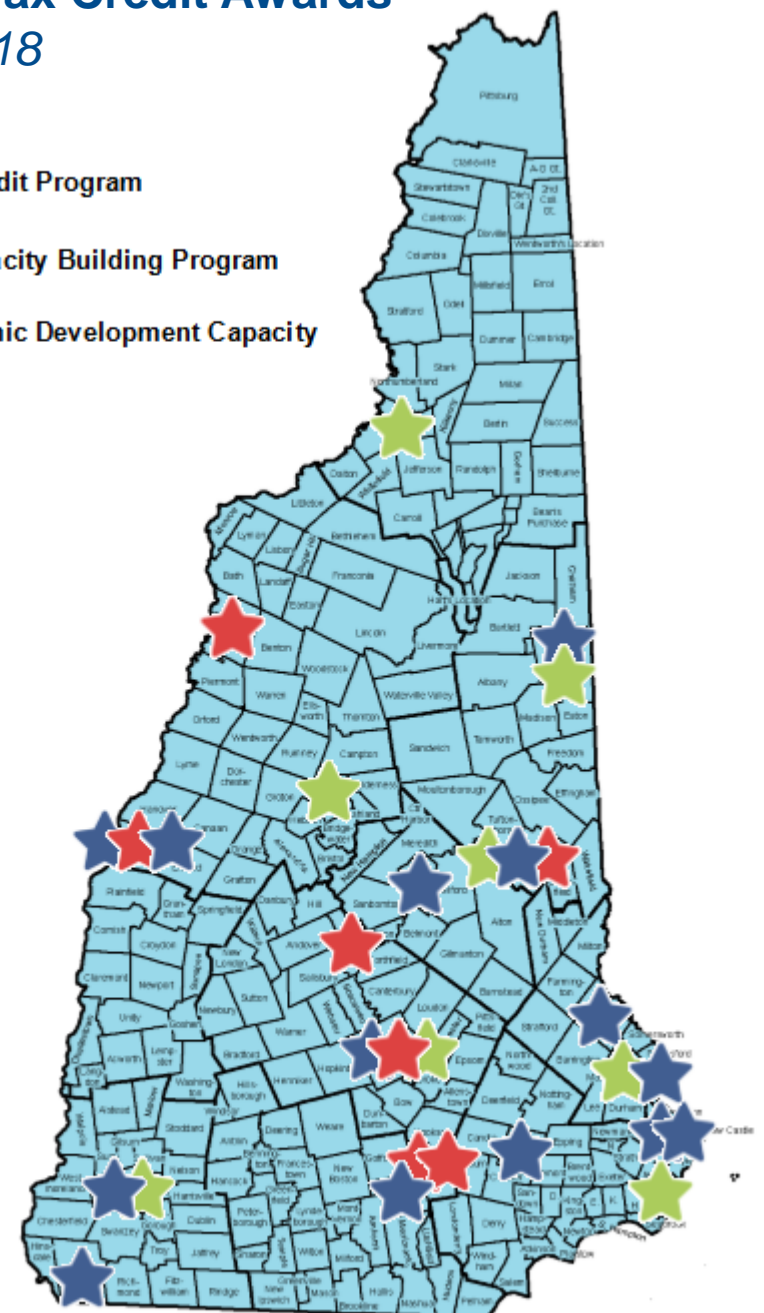

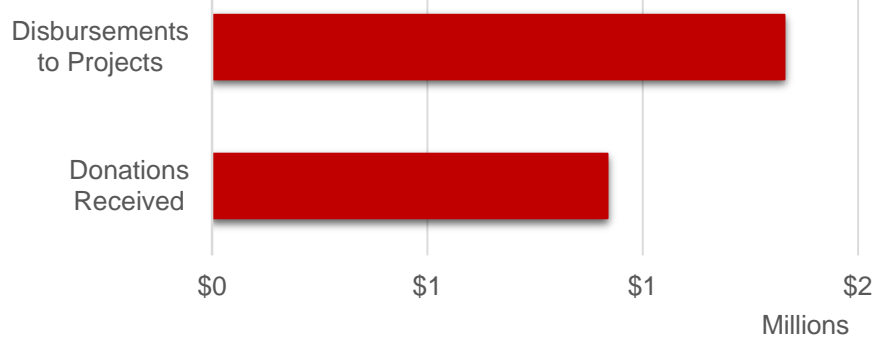
★ Tax Credit Program

Tax Credit Program



CDFA awarded \$4MM in SFY 2019 to support 29 projects across the state. Since 2016, CDFA has received tax credit applications totaling more than \$43.6 million in funding requests. Only 56 percent of these quality, community-based projects received CDFA funding due to a lack of resources.

Current Initiatives

- Conducted training for Opportunity Zone designees.
- Awarded 29 Tax Credit projects throughout NH.
- Advanced Recovery Friendly Workplace program development.
- Reviewed nine CDBG Housing and Public Facilities applications.
- Facilitated conversations around rural community and economic development opportunities at Radically Rural summit.
