\$17.8 million infused into New Hampshire communities

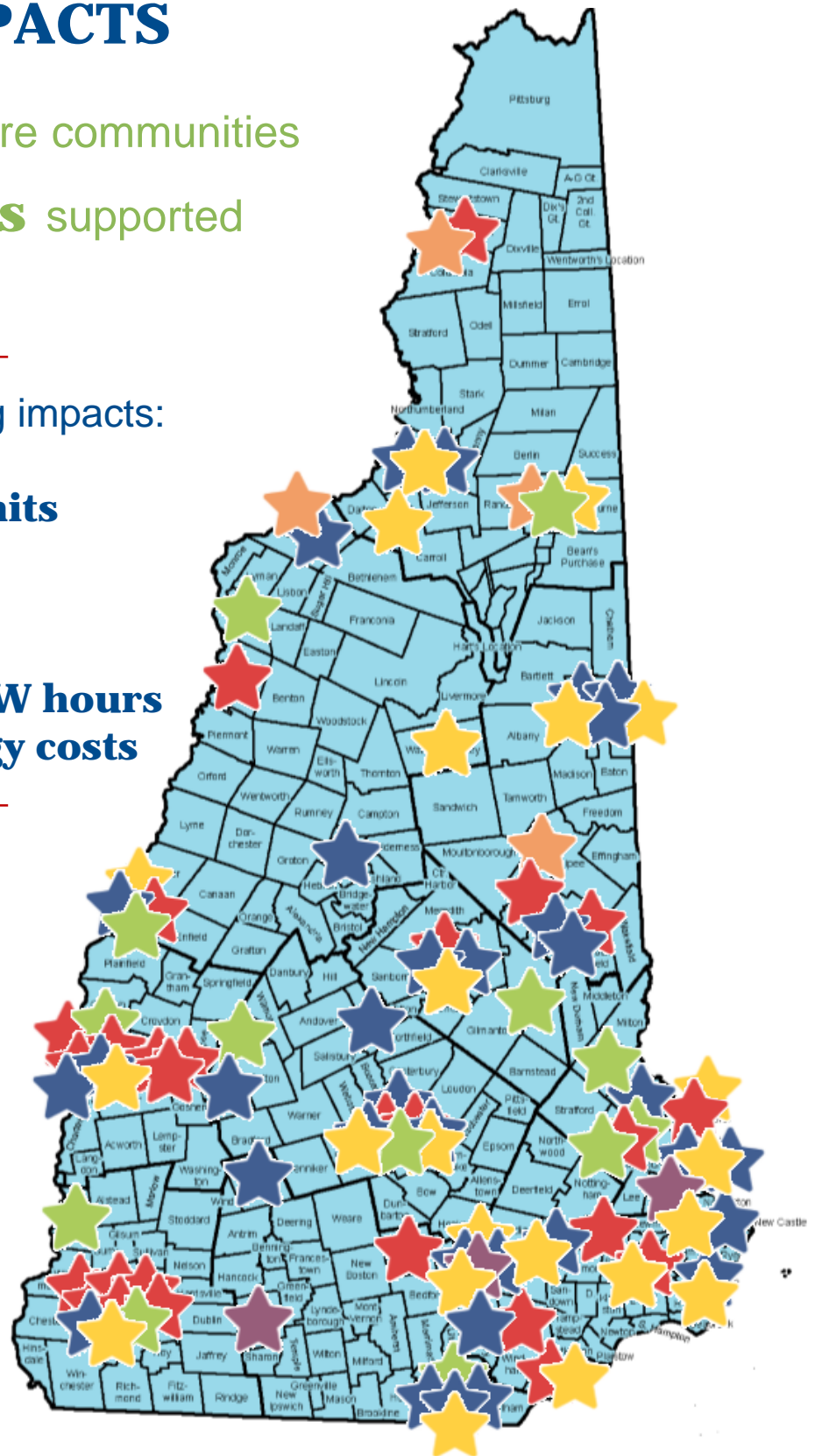
109 community-based initiatives supported
